BUT WE NEED YOUR HELP AS WE GROW AND AS WE MOVE INTO 2023!

Here are the specifics:

1. We ask for your commitment to a 1-year term.
2. Time commitment is approximately 10 hours or more per month. We get busier during "trip season" (April, May, June, July, September, October) but opportunities to contribute to the organization happen year-round. Be as involved as you commit to and more if you wish.
3. As a Board Member your ideas, opinions, your voice and vote matters. The best way to contribute to the organization is to attend Board Meetings. We ask that Board Members be willing to attend monthly / bi-monthly board meetings via video or conference call that are typically held on a weeknight. We ask that you commit to attending a zoom or other form of conference call meeting at least every other month or as needed. Quarterly in person Board member meeting attendance is required
4. We ask that you be an excellent Ambassador for Honor Flight Maine, freely sharing your positive experiences with friends, family, colleagues, neighbors, strangers, always promoting the organization and be willing to brainstorm ways to help raise funds to further the Mission. We will require a background check.
